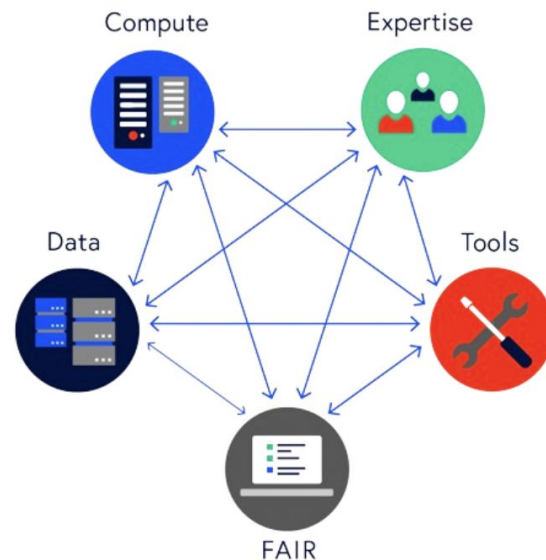

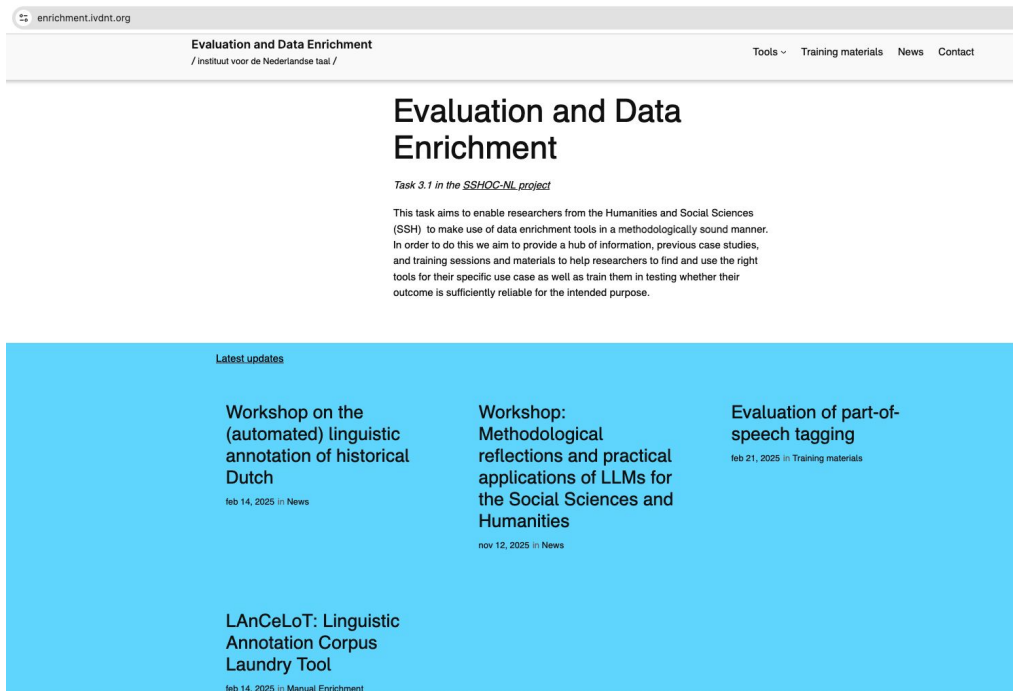

- LLM-as-lexicographer- Can open-source LLMs assist in writing dictionary definitions? (in progress: definitions generated; evaluation by multiple lexicographers about to start)
- MenTaal Gebruik- Collaboration with psychiatrists from AUMC looking at the way that Dutch newspapers use mental health disorder concepts over time (1995-2024)
